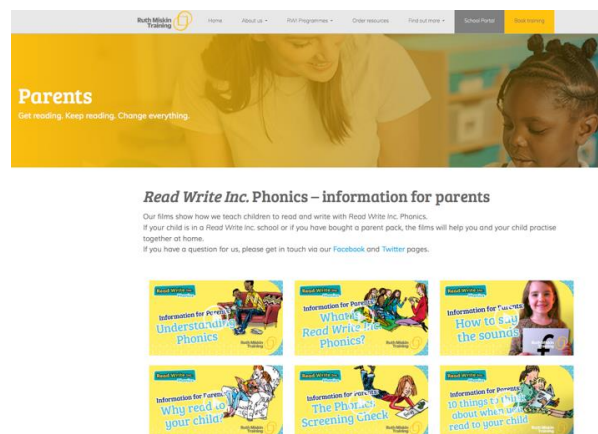
Listening to your child read - What can you do to help at home?

1. Listen to your child read the same home-school reading book again and again. This will help to increase their confidence and fluency.
2. Encourage them to use 'Special Friends', 'Fred Talk', 'read the word'.
3. Discuss the story and encourage their storyteller voice.
